## City Administrator's Message

Water Bond Project Information: The City Water Engineer is getting closer to being done with the 3rd bid packet, and they think it might fall into a more affordable price range! (Perhaps the 3rd time is the charm?) We are prepared to take out a small loan, to add to the \$5 million in bond funds that have been waiting for a successful bid, plus the \$2 million set aside in urban renewal funds. Please keep your fingers crossed that this time, we can finally get construction of the reservoirs and filtration plants started! We were informed by Representative Jami Cate two weeks ago that unfortunately, our request for capital funding for the water bond project was not funded by the Oregon Legislature even though it was a top priority of hers. The only grants available from the Federal Government for infrastructure, are for cities that have contaminated water, or problems with distribution or capacity. While we are thankful for not having those problems, it's still hard to deal with, when all we want is water that tastes, looks, and smells good! If you'd like to come and ask questions about steps we are taking then we encourage you to join us at a future City Council meeting. We meet on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesdays each month at 6:30pm, with the exception of the months of July, November and December.
